BOAT RULES

Because the boat is also my spring/summer/fall residence, it's not a free-for-all. Rules on the boat are simple:

18+ - NO EXCEPTIONS

- All visitors to the boat must be 18 years of age or older.
- If you look young for your age, you may be asked to show your ID.

INVITE ONLY!

- No visits to the boat location without an invitation, please.
- If you are invited, do not invite others to join you. The invite is for you only.
- I had more than a dozen weekends dedicated to ABDL visitors in 2019. Not every visitor will be invited to every weekend. If you are invited to some but not others, please don't take offense.



VETTING

- I often try to meet new visitors to the boat in a public place, i.e. coffee, lunch, etc.
- This allows me to meet you, and you to meet me, to gauge our comfort level with each other in a neutral space.
- I may make occasional exceptions to this on occasion, especially if you and I have talked for a long time or if you come recommended by other visitors to the boat.
- I also often run names by those who attend my get-togethers on a regular basis, asking for input before extending an invitation. If you've ghosted or otherwise mistreated one of my friends, there's a good chance you won't be joining us.

CONSENT IS KEY!

- Ask before anything. Touching, dirty talk, roleplay, etc.
- Don't touch anyone, anywhere, without their express consent.
- The universal safe word is "RED". Red means stop. No exceptions whatsoever.
- Don't pressure anyone into situations or scenes they're not comfortable in.
- No sulking, pouting, or otherwise boorish behavior if someone's just not into it.
- No leering, staring, or otherwise making someone uncomfortable.
- Speak to Cwis privately immediately if something makes you uncomfortable.


WHAT HAPPENS ON THE BOAT STAYS ON THE BOAT!

- Kindly keep it vanilla on the dock and elsewhere.
- Inside the boat is our 'little space'. Outside the boat is 'vanilla space'.
- The cuddle cabin in for cuddling. Enjoy it with consent!
- If having ABDL-related conversations or activities at the dock, close hatches please.
- Remember that sound carries across the water. Shhh!

SHARING IS NOT CARING.

If you've been invited to the boat, you are being trusted with information not available to the general public. It should go without saying that this information should not be shared. Still, here we are...

- Do not share the location of the boat.
- Do not share the city the boat is located in.
- Do not share the body of water the boat is located on.
- Do not share the name of the boat, or any other identifying characteristics of it.



- Do not share event details, i.e. guest list, calendar dates, and activities.
- Do not share locations of 'field trips' restaurant names, campsite names, etc.
- Those who do not respect the privacy of the boat will not be allowed to return.



- No photography without Cwis's permission.
- No photos of any boat visitors without their express permission.
- No sharing of photos without the permission of everyone in them.
- Location info off in photo settings, please. Ask if you need help.
- That said, photos are not required if you are a visitor to the 'Luvs Boat'. If you do choose to pose, face obscured or diaper close-up photos are fine.

THE SCOOP ON POOP...

- The #WhyABDL Survey I launched in 2018 revealed 51% of our community have some interest in 'messy' diapers.
- It's important to remember that many do not.
- Consideration of others is key on the boat.
- During group activities, for obvious reasons, messy diapers aren't allowed.
- During individual session messy diapers are only acceptable with Cwis's express permission.
- There is a good likelihood you will be required to change your own messy diapers.
- You will be asked to dispose of them outside of the marina.
- Anyone messing in a group setting or leaving messy diapers in public spaces will not be invited back to the boat.



NO 'FISHING!'

- Don't ask to be invited to the boat if your primary purpose for coming is to meet up with someone you've been crushing on. Message that person individually, and meet them at Starbucks or something. This is for everyone's safety and comfort.
- If you come to the boat to try to 'hook up' with the hottest boat visitor, you're the kind of visitor we try to avoid. This is the 'Luvs Boat', not the SS Matchmaker.
- Coming to the boat to try to fish for attendees to your own get-togethers, munches, and cons is just a little bit of low-class. Recruit online, like I did.

IF ASKED TO LEAVE...

If you are asked to leave the boat for any reason, please do so immediately; exit the boat, depart from the marina, and leave the premises with a minimum amount of drama.
